town taxes.

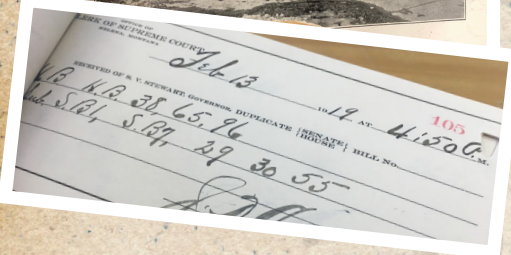
S. S. 29--relating to authority of County
