

2022 BROADWATER COUNTY FARM BUREAU SCHOLARSHIPS

This year the Broadwater County Farm Bureau is offering TWO scholarships to graduating high school seniors in Broadwater County - ONE (1) \$1000 Scholarship and ONE (1) \$500 Scholarship. An alternate will be named.

A student applying for this scholarship:

- A) Must be a Broadwater County graduating high school senior.
- B) Must be a graduating high school senior.
- C) Must be a U.S. citizen.
- D) MUST have their high school transcript attached to this application.

The applicant will be given from 0 to 5 points, in the following categories:

- 1) Scholastic Achievements & GPA
- 2) Leadership
- 3) School Activities
- 4) Community Service Activities
- 5) Financial Need of Student
- 6) Does applicant's family receive its principle income from agriculture?

The applicant will receive 1 point for a “yes” to the following question and 0 for a “no.”

- 7) Are applicant's immediate family Broadwater County Farm Bureau members?

Bonus Points:

- 8) An extra two (2) points can be given to applicants of family members who are ACTIVE in the county farm bureau.
- 9) An extra two (2) points can be given to applicants if their family are Century Club members of the Montana Farm Bureau Federation.

The winners will be chosen from the applications with the highest point total – providing it meets all the other application requirements. (See A, B, C above)

A scholarship committee will consist of at least three (3) Broadwater County Farm Bureau members. The committee will choose the scholarship recipients and an alternate.

Completed applications must be submitted to the high school counselor by **May 10, 2022.**

The awards will be given at graduation. Each scholarship recipient will receive a check written in the name of the recipient and also the name of the school indicated on his or her application.
