2018-2019 Mini Grant Application



What is the Mini Grant program?

Montana Farm Bureau Foundation has established a program to provide grants up to \$1,000.00 for use in educational forums or activities promoting agriculture.

What is the criteria for selection?

Proposals will be judged on the project's ability to address the following:

- Enhances participants' knowledge of agriculture and/or its contributions as an industry.
- Analyzes current agriculture issues or problems.
- Strengthen critical thinking and problem solving skills.
- Scope of audience reached.

Priority is given to projects that can be funded in whole by the mini grant or with the addition of matching funds by the applicant. Funding will not be awarded for services performed.

What is the application process?

Proposals for the 2018 - 2019 mini grant program can be submitted at any time. The grant committee will notify recipients approximately one month after the application is received. If awarded, one half of the funding will be given upon approval and the remaining upon completion. A brief written summary must be submitted upon the completion of the project, prior to the end of the 2019 calendar year. Note, ten mini grants will be awarded for the 2018-2019 fiscal year (October 1, 2018 - September 30, 2019).
